Tomu designs and builds prefabricated guest rooms for use in hospitality construction using its proprietary modular building system to address the shortage in lodging supply and emerging traveler demand for more sustainable travel options. The company's guest units come in both pre-designed and configurable options, allowing both independent and franchised hotel operators a way to reduce project development times and lower ongoing operating costs. Tomu was also recently named a **finalist in the 2023 Hospitality Design Awards** in the Sustainable Solutions category.

"We've been working toward this moment for quite some time," said Chris Osaka, Chief Executive Officer of Tomu, Inc., "This financing is the accelerant that propels us into our next phase of growth, allowing us to scale our manufacturing facilities and begin production of larger volume orders."
